We are also able to design and develop gardens in line with customer requirements.

## Working opportunities for people with learning disabilities

Our unique approach offers a mutually beneficial relationship. It enables your gardens to receive excellent care, whilst helping provide people with learning disabilities the opportunity to develop essential job skills, improve their self esteem and gain confidence.
